Dear Parents and Carers,

For the final half term this year we will be learning about animals. As part of this we will be learning about farm animals. To support with this learning we will be taking the children to Stockley Farm.

The children will:

- Have a tractor and trailer ride around the farm
- Meet the different farm animals including goats, cows, sheep, pigs and more
- Meet the animals in Pets' Corner
- Feed the chickens
- Meet, and possibly brush, the Shetland ponies
- Learn about the birds of prey

They may also:

- Explore the polytunnel
- Visit the nature trail
- Bottle feed the baby goats/lambs

The visits will take place on:

Tuesday 10 <sup>th</sup> July	Mrs Chadwick's registration group Mr Chruszcz's Monday-Wednesday Nursery children  Mrs Martin's registration group and Mrs Diamond's Nursery children should attend school as normal.
Thursday 12 <sup>th</sup> July	Mrs Martin's registration group Mrs Diamond's Wednesday-Friday Nursery children  Mrs Chadwick's registration group and Mr Chruszcz's Nursery children should attend school as normal.

We will be leaving school at 9:15am and will return at normal time for the end of school. Children must wear school uniform and appropriate shoes/wellies for the weather. Please remember to apply suncream if we are lucky with the sun!

If your child normally has a school dinner they can be provided with a packed lunch. If you would prefer to provide your own packed lunch please indicate this on the slip. Please make sure that all packed lunches are in a named carrier bag with disposable containers, including spoons etc., so that all items can be thrown away afterwards.

To cover the cost of the coach and the entry price, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15.15 from each child. **Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions to pay for the coaches and entry the visit will have to be cancelled.**

If your child suffers from any medical conditions, including asthma or travel sickness, please indicate this on the slip. We are also asking for parent volunteers to help on the visit. Please indicate on the slip below if you would be willing to help. We will draw names from a hat if we have too many volunteers.

Please return all slips and make voluntary contributions by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018 so that we know whether or not the visit can go ahead.
