Think before we speak.

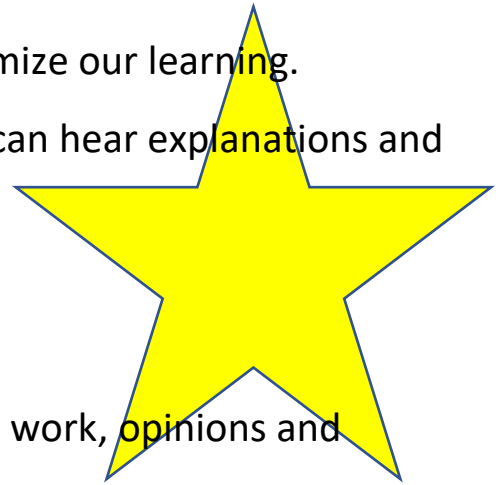
Try to always have a happy smile and spread positivity.
