THINGS TO REMEMBER!

Please make sure that your child brings their book bag to school everyday.

Reception children should have their reading book and reading record book in their book bag daily. These will be given out soon!
Reception children also need a PE kit which can be left on their peg for the half term.

All uniform items and PE kits should be named clearly. It may also be helpful to have a set of spare, dry clothes on your child's peg in a named carrier bag on their peg, particularly if they are prone to toileting 'accidents'.
