
### **Year 5 Newsletter**

## **English**

This half term we will be looking at diary writing. The text that we will be studying is The Diary of Anne Frank. Children will be learning the spelling, punctuation and grammar rules which are relevant to basic sentence structure, diary writing, letter writing and poetry. Spellings are provided half termly and are tested each Friday. Reading records are to be completed by the children or an adult as frequently as is appropriate, but at least twice weekly.

### Maths

Learning this term is based around reviewing and extending our knowledge of place value, place value with decimals, rounding, Roman numerals, column addition, subtraction, multiplication, factors of 2 digit numbers, time and equivalent fractions. Please remember to practise times tables with your child. (Year Five children should already know multiplication and division facts for all multiplication tables up to 12x12.) Asking the children questions about the time from analogue and digital clocks, will also help embed this skill.

### **Science**

This half term we will be studying forces, such as gravity, friction, air resistance and water resistance.

Next half term we will be looking at properties and changes of materials.

Through these sessions we will be looking at dissolving and separating solutions by investigating how to separate mixtures by filtering, sieving and evaporating.

### Homework

Homework is given out on a Friday and is to be returned the following Wednesday Children will usually receive a piece of English and a piece of maths homework.
