

CURRICULUM

This half term we will be exploring the topic of pets. We will be looking carefully at different texts such as the Tiger who came to Tea and Dogger. We will be writing character descriptions and writing our own stories. To enrich our topic we are hoping to have a visitor from Pets as Therapy who will bring a dog to show to the children and talk about the work that they do. MENTAL MATHS AND SPELLING TESTS

Spellings are given out each half term and spelling tests and mental maths tests will be every Friday. Children will be given individual mental maths to practise each week and you will be informed when your child is moving on to the next maths test.

Homework is given out each Friday and will alternate between maths and English, occasionally the children may be asked to do a creative project. Homework folders need to be returned to school on a Wednesday morning to give staff time to mark the homework.

Children are expected to put their own homework folder in the homework box.
